Once normal schedules resume, meetings will be held again at the Montgomery County Human Service Center, 1430 DeKalb Street Norristown, Pennsylvania. When this happens, it will become a combination of live with Zoom.
- Be available for at least 80% of the Board Meetings per year.
- Attend Membership Meetings: Must be available for membership kick off (Sept) and year-end (May) meetings with a total of 50% of all Member Meetings. Available to attend as many other membership meetings as possible.
- Actively participates in board meeting discussions and decisions.
- Votes on pending board matters.
- Takes an active role by serving on at least one sub-committee, which includes, but is not limited to Program Development, Membership and Recruitment, Grant Writing and Fundraising.
- Advises and assists the ICN Coordinator in the development and the implementation of ICN Mission.
- Responsibility to the ICN Board President.
